

A LETTER

(Below is a copy of the letter written by William Stephens, Jr., and sent to the Church of God of Prophecy at East Point, Georgia.)

January 11, 1957

To the clerk of the Church of God of Prophecy, East Point, Georgia:

In humble submittance I write the following to the Church of God of Prophecy at East Point, Georgia.

Be it known to every member of said church that I, William Stephens, report my stand for God and His Church in obedience to the covenant which I took when becoming a member of the Church of God that I would walk in the light to the best of my knowledge and ability, therefore, I request that my membership be no longer at the Church of God of Prophecy as I have followed the glorious light shown me through the revelation of God's Word and not by the influence of man or men. I do not move because I dislike any member or members. I love everyone of you, but that I may save my soul from a burning hell and can stand before God at Judgment with a clear record. That this understanding will be known by every member or friend of the Church. I request that it be read before the congregation at a major gathering and not hid from any. I beg that I not leave you but that I may greet you at your coming; to leave behind me a reputation of good and faithful work. I beg to remain your brother in Christ as I follow the true light.
