The world is in need of a powerful Evangelistic System of soul-saving like has never been known since the early days as described in Acts 17:6, "And when they found them not, they drew Jason and certain brethren unto the rulers of the city, crying, 'These that have turned the world upside down are come hither also.

Jesus commissioned the church to go into all the world. He declared that these signs would follow the true believers. Healing the sick, casting out devils, raising the dead, speaking with new tongues, handling serpents and if they should drink anything deadly it shall not hurt them.

When you think of the New Testament Evangelism and 'work of the ministry', you think of a mighty powerful movement that jailhouses or nothing else can phase it or stop it. We have some mighty men throughout the land who specialize in healing and various other Bible beliefs, but I have never read in books or any other source of information where the New Testament System of Evangelism is existing.

For such a ministry movement to operate in our day, it is necessary for ministers to obtain gifts--such as the five gifts of the ministry: Apostles, Prophets, Evangelists, Pastors and Teachers as referred to in Ephesians 4:11-12. A minister, after he has been called to preach the Gospel, to be a great success in any of these fields--he must obtain one or more of these five.

In conjunction with the five gifts of the ministry, there are nine other gifts he can receive as well as one of the gifts of the ministry. For an example: Philip, the Evangelist, as well as having the gift of evangelism, he also operated the gift of working of miracles--but, it was necessary for the brethren to come down from Jerusalem, Peter and John, and use their gifts of receiving the Holy Ghost by the laying on of hands which is one of the signs of the gift of an apostle. This is supported and backed up by the 8th chapter of Acts of the Apostles in the great revival conducted by Philip in Samaria. This view of the Scriptures clearly points out, in verses 14-17, what has been lacking in the evangelistic field of the church -- that of signs and wonders confirming the Word--Many ministers being qualified to obtain such gifts that will make the church edifying. It is good to put forth an effort for other material things but they are not to be first. A powerful evangelistic system confirmed by signs and wonders, mighty miracles of even raising the dead is what the church is striving for in this mighty reformation. Reforming the church according to the New Testament Pattern earnestly contended for the faith that was once delivered unto the saints as instructed by the beloved Jude.

THE GIFTS TO THE CHURCH as well as in the ministry -- The church has an opportunity for many benefits to bring about a body to the edifying of its self with love and receiving gifts. In the 12th chapter of I Corinthians, verses 1-11 -- it clearly shows there are nine gifts for the body. In the 11th verse, and I quote, "But all these worketh that one and the self same Spirit, dividing to every man severally as he will." These gifts are divided to every man severally (or individually). When I learned the real meaning of this 11th verse, I learned these gifts were not given to a collective body but to the individual in the body. This Scripture points out that all the body does not have this gift. Only to be a member of the body in which the individual who believes God to the extent to qualifying himself.

He gives them one of these gifts. Perhaps, the one that you most greatly desire. This mighty body of people has not existed since the days of the early church. No church since the days of the falling away has brought such a powerful movement. But thanks be to God the Move Is One!
