


At The End

My Annual Visit To Fields of The Wood



This has been the promise to every Prophet. And to every dispensation God promised them that the revelation of the mystery would speak at the end after the man chosen to reveal it had written it upon tables of stone. The disciple whom Jesus loved was granted the privilege to operate in the spirit of Habakkuk. He designed in the material things the revelation of each marker placed in the Fields of The Wood. The writer knew these things to be true and no one else on earth would know better than he. Anyone reading the first chapter of Revelation, verses one through four could not deny the fact that God transferred the revelation and vision of all to his servant, John, and also granted to him that it was for

I was privileged again to visit Fields of the Wood on the 25th day of August, just prior to the 53rd Annual Assembly, to have another view of the glorious revelation of which I toiled night and day and sometimes preached all night since 1940 to stimulate and to raise money to portray the heavenly vision on tables of stone. I hazarded my life many times to boost this project. Those who know the history of this vision know that I tell the truth and lie not if they would only be honest and truthful. Let me warn them again not to misconstrue the truth. I provided the revelation of the markers to the General Overseer and second to L. S. Rhodes. If Brother Rhodes will tell the facts, he will tell you that I explained the revelation to him from the Scriptures. If Brother George Albert Wilson will remember the day that Brother Elford N. Collins, Harry Lee Moore and myself came to the Fields of The Wood, he wept and shed tears on the cross as I signed my resignation and I quote, "Brother Kent don't do that. We have always got the revelation from you of everything in Fields of The Wood and what will we do if you resign." Brother Harry L. Moore, remember, he was a witness to these words for he spent the entire night with me declaring that I was making the greatest move I had ever made in my life, and that he was with me in making it, but now has gone back. Brother Jack Decker hugged my neck and kissed me declaring it to be the greatest move that I had ever made and said that his kiss was not a Judas kiss. There is a God in heaven Who holds a truthful record. I will face these same words in Judgment too; I tell the truth and do not lie.
